There are trees that have a low survivability rate when dug in the fall months
 The trees listed below are only dug in the Spring.

Acer Rubrum	Maple
Betula Sp.	Birch
Carpinus sp.	Hornbeam
Celtis sp.	Hackberry
Cercis sp.	Redbud
Cercidiphyllum	Katsura
Cornus sp.	Dogwood
Crataegus sp.	Hawthorne
Fagus sp.	Beech
Halesia sp.	Silverbell
Ilex opaca varieties	American Holly
Liquidambar	Sweetgum
Liriodendron varieties	Tulip Tree
Malus sp.	Apple Tree
NYSSA sylvatica	Tupelo/Blackgum
Platanus sp.	Planetree
Prunus varieties	Plums/Cherries/Peaches
Pyrus sp.	Pear
Quercus sp.	Oak
Salix - Weeping varieties	Weeping Willow Taxodium distichum
Tillia tomentosa	Linden
Zelkova varieties	Zelkova

Other deciduous trees may have difficulty by being dug in the fall, so it is good to check first.
